

#### LABOR FORCE

In 2000, Cascade had 340 residents, 65.6% of the population, in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

### **WATER & SEWER**

The Village is served by its own Cascade Waterworks, which draws groundwater. The Village of Cascade is served by the Cascade Wastewater Treatment Facility, which also provides service for Lake Ellen Sanitary District No. 1. This Village is pursuing installing wind turbines that would reduce operating costs of the treatment plant

#### **TELECOMMUNICATIONS**

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon north. Time Warner Cable offers broadband services.

#### TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Cascade is located along State Highway 28 and County Roads NN and F. Rail service is not available in the Village of Cascade. Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 10 miles away.

#### **HOUSING**

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$99,100, which is less than the median housing value of the entire County.
