


Village of Cedar Grove, WI ECONOMIC PROFILE

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, Cedar Grove had 1,022 residents (16 and older), or 72.8% of residents, in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Cedar Grove is located a half mile from Interstate 43 and along State Highway 32. Union Pacific (UP) provides rail service to the Village. The Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 15 miles from Cedar Grove.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$117,400 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there is one Business Park in the Village of Cedar Grove. The park is along State Highway 32 (Union Ave.) and S. Commerce Street, less than 1 miles from Interstate-43. Additional adjacent land may be developed in the future.
