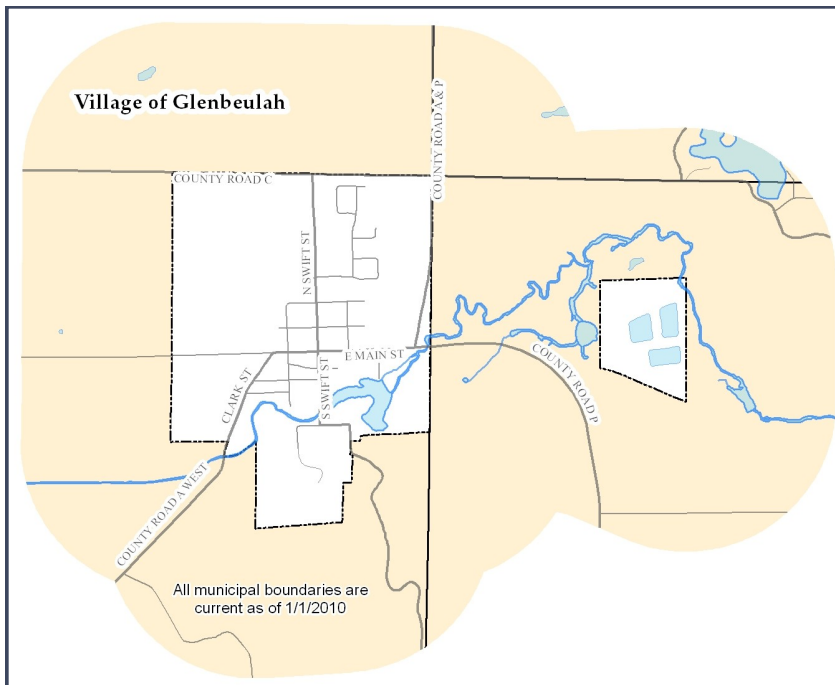




Village of Glenbeulah, WI

ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Village of Glenbeulah is located in northwest Sheboygan County on the northern edge of the Kettle Moraine State Forest. The Village of Glenbeulah is small, family-oriented village with a mix of residences and small businesses. Slow, but steady growth, and a high quality of life define this community. Glenbeulah values a small community atmosphere that is quiet and safe. Glenbeulah considers the Mill Pond and surrounding forest to be outstanding natural assets.



POPULATION

Glenbeulah's population increased by nearly 16% between 2000 and 2009 and was the second fastest growing village in Sheboygan County.

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, Glenbeulah had 234 residents in the labor force, or 76.5% of the total population. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Village provides the public water system and is jointly involved in the Northern Moraine Wastewater Treatment Facility with the Village of Elkhart Lake, unincorporated Greenbush, Sanitary District #1 of Rhine and Plymouth.

Provided by Wisconsin Public Service (WPS).

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon north. Time Warner Cable offers broadband services.

TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Glenbeulah is located along County Roads A, A&P, C, and P. The Village is less than 1.5 miles from State Highway 23. There is no rail service in Glenbeulah. The Sheboygan County Memorial Airport is 13 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$84,500, less than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS
