


Village of Kohler, WI

In 2000, Kohler had 952 residents, or 69.9% of its population, in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

WATER & SEWER

The Village provides the public water system and sewer, but wastewater is treated at the Sheboygan Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility, located in the City of Sheboygan.

TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Kohler is located along Interstate-43 and State Highways 23 and 28. Rail access is proved by the Union Pacific Railroad (UP). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 3 miles away.

BUSINESS PARKS
