


Town of Holland, WI

ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Town of Holland is located in southeastern Sheboygan County along the Ozaukee County border and Lake Michigan shoreline. Holland promotes long-term development that enhances the rural atmosphere of the community by maintaining agricultural land and the farming industry; preserving the landscape's natural features and open space; promoting the community's heritage; and guiding attractive, high-quality public and private investment. The Town of Holland surrounds the Village of Cedar Grove and Oostburg as well as the unincorporated area of Dacada.

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, the Town had 1,348 residents in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Town of Holland does not have a public water system or a public sewer system. Residents within the Town have individual wells and on-site sanitary systems that are owned and maintained by individual property owners.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by AT&T and Verizon North. Broadband internet is offered by Time Warner in parts of the town.

TRANSPORTATION

The Town is intersected by Interstate 43 and State Highway 32. Rail service is provided by the Union Pacific Railroad (UP). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 16 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$148,500 and is lower than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no Business Parks in the Town of Holland. The Town of Holland plans to direct new commercial or industrial development to areas on key intersections near the Villages of Cedar Grove and Oostburg according to their 2030 Future Land Use Map. These sites are suitable for commercial and industrial development that fits with the existing character of the Town. The Village of Cedar Grove and Oostburg both have business parks to accommodate projects that the Town cannot.

INCOME

The Town's median household income in 1999 was \$57,419, which was higher than the State and Federal median household income.
