


Town of Scott. WI

The Town of Scott is located in southwestern Sheboygan County. The Town of Scott is a safe, family friendly community with a blend of agriculture, open/green space, and single-family residences in harmony with its natural resources. The Town of Scott surrounds the hamlets of Batavia and Beechwood. The Town has a few commercial and industrial businesses. The Town is home to the Kettle Moraine State Forest-Northern Unit.

LABOR FORCE

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Town of Scott does not have a public water system. Residents within the Town have individual wells that are owned and maintained by individual property owners. Approximately 490 acres of the Town of Scott, completely within Section 13, is within the Batavia Sanitary District. The remainder of the residents of the Town are responsible for installing and maintaining their own individual septic systems.

Provided by We Energies, Plymouth Utilities, or Alliant Energy depending on location.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon North. Broadband internet is offered by Time Warner Cable where available.

TRANSPORTATION

The Town is intersected State Highways 28 and 144. Rail service is not available. Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 21 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$125,000 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no business parks in the Town of Scott, and there are no plans to have a business park in the future. The Town of Scott might look at a small area of light industrial development in the future. Future commercial sites may be located along Highway 28 or near Beechwood and Batavia. As the Town of Scott does not have public water and has limited sewer, large business and industrial growth is better suited for other areas.

INCOME

The Town's median household income in 1999 was \$51,771, which was higher than the State and Federal median household income.
