


## Town of Sherman, WI

The Town of Sherman is located in southwestern Sheboygan County along the Ozaukee County border. #### **UTILITIES**

## WATER & SEWER

The Town of Sherman does not have a public water system or a public sewer system. Residents within the Town have individual wells and on-site sanitary systems that are owned and maintained by individual property owners.

### **TELECOMMUNICATIONS**

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon North. Broadband internet is offered by Time Warner Communications where available.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

The Town is intersected State Highways 57 and 144. Rail service is provided by the Wisconsin and Southern Railroad (WSOR). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is located 18 miles away.

#### **HOUSING**

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$133,300 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

### **BUSINESS PARKS**

Currently there are no business parks in the Town of Sherman, but there is a thriving industrial park in the Village of Random Lake. As the Town of Sherman does not have public sewer or water, large business and industrial growth is better suited for other areas.
