Innovative Financial Solutions

The Osthoff Resort, in Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin, is a premier AAA Four Diamond resort located on 500 feet of recreational lakefront. While serving as an inviting vacation destination for many years, the property also provides large meeting spaces for business conferences and special events.

During their strategic planning process in 2012, the resort realized that many times, particularly in the off-season, their conference space would be completely full yet there were still guest rooms available. Upon further market analysis, the resort realized that there was an opportunity to provide the area with a larger facility that could accommodate larger weddings, corporate retreats and special events. To meet that need, the resort decided to increase the size of their already popular conference center.

Understanding that financing was going to play a significant role in the project, Osthoff Resort General Manager, Lola Roeh, turned to the Sheboygan County Economic Development Corporation for assistance.

Dane Checolinski, Director of the SCEDC, began to research the various options available and steered Ms. Roeh and her team towards the Sheboygan County Revolving Loan Fund (RLF). This federally funded, community development grant was part of an intricate

financing package that was interdependent on all of the financial partners. Because The Osthoff Resort, with the SCEDC's assistance, was able to secure the RLF, all of the other financing pieces, including financing from the Village of Elkhart Lake through a TID, easily fell into place.

As a result of this collaboration, The Osthoff created Sheboygan County's largest meeting room in under nine months. It added an additional 23,000 square feet to their operation and increased employment to almost 450 associates. The new space minimizes the affect of lower occupancy times during the year while providing consistent, yearlong employment for our core staff.
